Threads of discussions

1. The meeting went over the feedback regarding the ideas to reboot the Security Work Group.
 - Alan went over his three points
 - a) Sales. The ability to access the impact dynamically when vulnerability occurs.
 - b) Real time intervention. Allow things to continue to operate, put restrictions on particular process.
 - c) Standards. Allow to express such requirements and to implement them on running architecture.
 - d) Identifying users. Federal users and public users are different in asserting identity.
 - Objectives of the security work group.
 - a) Align security issues in guidance to FedRAMP controls.
 - b) The objectives of this work group will go beyond the FedRAMP.
 - c) The objective is to address security concerns and feeding the roadmap from the security perspective.
 - d) This meeting is to stimulate ideas from the participants.
 - e) Provide vision to the objective.
 - f) FedRAMP currently has no guidance at the (federal) consumer side of the cloud computing.
 - g) Come up with standards to help Federal executives in decision/contract making process.
