- Status of 7628 v2: Tanya has just a little more work putting new privacy use case language into the draft and then it’s done. We will be putting out the entire document for CSWG early next year (late Jan, early Feb). After the CSWG review, there will be a public review period of 60 days. A Federal Register Notice will go out before the public review period.

- The future of this group:
 - Rebecca received information from SGIP 2.0. The name change will take effect on January 1. We will then be referred to as the Cybersecurity Committee. We will continue with our current CSWG membership until early March when the official switchover will occur. Any work not finished as of March 2013 will be transferred to the members-only group.
