Here are my summary notes from the meeting:

1. Team reports

- Matrix update: Rebecca Herold
 - Did no work this week because of traveling.
 - Have a few sections to go; anticipate finishing next week.
 - Teams should use the matrix to ensure all applicable groups, issues are included from it within their work.
- NSTIC Team: Tanya reported:
 - Will hold short meetings until the NSTIC DHS report is released in December.
 - There may be an NSTIC pilot project in the realm of Smart Grid.
 - Will discuss pilot project in meantime.
- PEV Team: Mike Coop, Hey Coop! (team lead)
 - No one else is looking at privacy issues related to PEVs so will be starting from scratch.
 - Probably will meet Mondays right after the CSWG call.
- Third Party Team: Brent Struthers, Neustar (team lead)
 - Will take interface category 16, go through it and see if there should be any privacy controls based upon the third parties touching the info
 - Meeting Wednesdays at 2pm eastern time
- Privacy Use Cases Team: Christine Hertzog (team lead)
 - Meeting on Thursdays at 10am
 - Will use the OECD privacy principles
 - Focusing on the residential to start with
 - Looking at decisions coming from the FCC
 - Could provide a good attempt at balancing legitimate needs with addressing concerns
 - Next week will take the TCCI (sic?) they are using and ask the utilities how they will assign use cases individually.

2. Other topics: Open floor

- Brent: Will invite FBI representative to speak and discuss what the FBI be accessing, or will want to access, on the Smart Grid.
- Klaus: In EU encryption is being created specifically for Smart Grid data. Will get some folks from Microsoft working on this involved and ask them to speak.
