Portland blocks are only 250 feet long and it is rare that you go more than 3 blocks on any route without passing a Starbucks or equivalent coffee house if all you want is a bagel or scone. The closest Coffee spot to WTC is James Bean Café 110 SW Yamhill, they also serve basic breakfasts like eggs and toast. Directly across the street is a Starbucks. Both are a 2 min Walk to WTC
