Six Standards Now Open for Comment

Announced last week, the Catalog of Standards (CoS) process and structure was approved by the SGIP Governing Board. As a result, the SGIP Administrator has been tasked with establishing the ballot for the six (6) standards and guidelines that have completed the CoS process. The Standards Information Forms (SIFs) is now posted on the Twiki for each of the following standards:

PAP 0 - NEMA SG-AMI 1-2009 Requirements for Smart Meter Upgradeability

PAP 1 - IETF Internet Protocol Standards for Smart Grid

PAP 2 - NISTIR 7761 Guidelines for Assessing Wireless Standards for Smart Grid Applications

PAP 10 - NAESB Energy Usage Information

PAP 11 - SAE J1772-TM-2010 Electric Vehicle and Plug in Hybrid Electric Vehicle Conductive Charge Coupler

PAP 11 - SAE J2836/1 Use Cases for Communication Between Plug-in Vehicles and the Utility Grid

These are now open for comment. Once the comment period is complete, we will perform a final comments resolution activity and open the ballot for voting.

Eligible voting member representatives will be notified by email from the Administrator once the ballot is open. All members will be notified once the materials have been posted for review. Stay tuned for more details coming soon.
