CDF status update:

VVSG 2.0 Principles and Guidelines:

We looked at the current draft, very few changes to the Interoperability principles, Scalability was subsumed into a guideline that covers general qualities of voting systems.

JW urged people to look at the document and send in any comments prior to the TGDC meeting, comments can be sent to the Interoperability mailing list.

VRI spec comments:

JW thanked John Dziurlaj, Carl Hage, John McCarthy, John Sebes, and Stafford Ward for sending comments and doing reviews of the VRI spec.

The most up-to-date version of the spec is on <https://pages.nist.gov/VoterRecordsInterchange>.

John Dz and John Sebes want to get the spec out asap so that it could be used now. JW will hold a separate review meeting with VR vendors and strive to get spec out during month of Sep, 2017.

There was some question about using internal XML identifiers (objectIds) as external identifiers, OCD-IDs are better for external purposes and JW would like to be in a position to do more outreach on OCD-ID usage.

There was also discussion on use of the FGDC thoroughfare standard, John Sebes believes some separate guidance should be developed but does not think it needs to be extensive, most addresses could fit within one of several templates. JW will add this to his list.
